

# THE PAULÉE D'ANJOU WILL TAKE PLACE ON JUNE 19, 2023 TO CELEBRATE THE TERROIRS OF THE HISTORIC PROVINCE OF ANJOU

To highlight the exceptional wines, terroirs, and locations of Anjou Noir, Anjou Blanc, Saumur, Bourgueil, and Saint-Nicolas de Bourgueil, the winemakers are gathering this year at the Jean Lurçat Museum in Angers.



## THE PAULÉE, A COLLECTIVE STORY BETWEEN ANJOU NOIR, ANJOU BLANC, SAUMUR AND BOURGUEIL

For this 11th edition, the collective of winemakers is meeting at a historical location in the capital of Anjou Noir, the Jean Lurçat Museum. The Paulée d'Anjou collective works with a common goal: promoting the terroirs, history, and wines of Anjou by showcasing its landscapes, great wines, heritage, and the spirit of winemakers practicing artisanal, organic viticulture\*.

## A NEW EDITION UNDER THE SIGN OF CONVIVIALITY AND SHARING

The Paulée d'Anjou 2023 warmly invites all wine lovers to better understand the history, geology, and cultural practices of this historic wine region. This day promises to be rich in tastings of organic wines (organic, biodynamic, or in conversion) from almost 100 domains, as well as discoveries of the region through a geo-sensory excursion to Savennières.

The Paulée will open at 10 am with a Round table discussion on the theme of the great wines of Anjou with the participation of Jean-Michel Deiss, Jacky Rigaux, Ronan Laborde, and the American journalist Jon Bonné. The tasting will take place between 10 am and 6 pm at the Jean Lurçat Museum. The day will end with the traditional gala dinner, which will be held at the Grenier Saint-Jean, under the sign of conviviality and sharing.

## AN AMBASSADOR OF FRENCH WINES - JON BONNÉ

For this 11th edition of the Paulée d'Anjou, Jon Bonné has been chosen as the guest of honor. He is a renowned American author and journalist in the field of wine and gastronomy and is currently the editor-in-chief of RESY, a platform listing the best restaurants in the world. His years as a contributing editor at PUNCH earned him the award for writer of the year at "the 2017 Roederer Awards" and best columnist at "the 2018 IACP Awards". His passion for writing and wine has led him to write books, including *The New California Wine and The New Wine Rules*. He has just published a new reference book on the French vineyard: *The New French Wine*.



## CHENIN, CABERNET FRANC: THE TWO "STAR" GRAPE VARIETIES OF THE LOIRE

The Paulée d'Anjou brings together more than 90 participating estates from the historic Province of Anjou and is once again coming together this year to celebrate the great single-varietal wines of **Chenin Blanc** and **Cabernet Franc**. Guests will have the opportunity to delve into the fascinating diversity of Angevin terroirs through these two iconic Loire grape varieties.

### AN EXCEPTIONAL DINNER IN A HISTORIC LOCATION

At the end of the day, the gastronomic festivities will take place at Grenier Saint-Jean, in the heart of the Doutre district, on the banks of the Maine. Three chefs of Angers, Pascal Favre d'Anne, David Guitton and Mickaël Pihours, will showcase local organic products for a gala dinner focused on conviviality and sharing.



## THE PAULÉE D'ANJOU: A COLLECTIVE INITIATIVE IN FAVOR OF THE ANGERS VITICULTURAL HERITAGE

The Paulée d'Anjou is a collective adventure initiated in 2012 by the winemakers of Anjou Noir who wanted to promote their shale terroirs and has gradually expanded to all the great terroirs from Angers. The 2019 edition marked an important step in this dynamic by bringing together for the first time the shales of Anjou Noir and the limestone of Anjou Blanc. This solidarity was reinforced in 2021 with the welcome of winemakers from Bourgueil and St-Nicolas-de-Bourgueil! To formalize their commitment, the collective winemakers have established a charter that defines their values, missions, and ethics. The participating winemakers thus commit to promoting:

- All the riches of Anjou: its landscapes and biodiversity, its wines from unique and inimitable terroirs, its millennial history, its heritage of "beautiful stones," its gastronomy, its culture and its artists, etc.
- A responsible and sustainable viticulture method, of which the region was one of the pioneers, presenting only certified vintages or those in the process of being certified organic or biodynamic.
- **Humanistic values**, so often embodied by Loire Valley winemakers: open-mindedness and temperance, inter-generational solidarity promoting the installation of young talents, etc.

An event of international dimension, the Paulée d'Anjou attracts each year more and more winemakers willing to join this ambitious collective dynamic. For the 2022 edition, more than 90 estates, from the "great figures" to the "young guard" freshly installed, invite you to join them for this moment of conviviality, culture and sharing.
